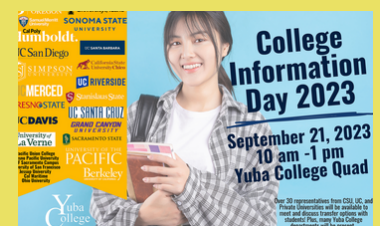


Attention High School Seniors!

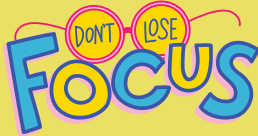
Read the questions - then read the material to find the answers

Search online for supporting details

Read the question again, analyze the information you gather, formulate your answer - Do not be afraid of making a mistake or writing something different from everyone else

Ask your teacher - review it together - Don't make your teacher or the person you ask your first and only source. You need to use the resources available to you... if you are able to do this, you will be very successful in everything you do.

Recommendations: Read, try, review, try again, ask questions to clarify.. Do not allow anyone to do it for you... When you are able to complete the task, you will have learned how to attain the correct answer, result or response, but you will also be able to discover the paths and ways that led you in a different direction. Everything is a learning process.

Recomendaciones: Lee, experimenta, revisa, vuelve a intentar, haz preguntas para aclarar... No permitas que nadie lo haga por ti... Cuando seas capaz de completar la tarea, habrás aprendido cómo obtener la respuesta, resultado o respuesta correcta, y también podrás descubrir los caminos que te llevaron en una dirección diferente. Todo es un proceso de aprendizaje.
